Tony made a costly error, rather than use the net on a very small Roach he decided to swing in the 2 ozs fish as per normal, an exercise we've all done thousands of times, you've guessed... it came off much to much laughter from some of the other competitors, it was the only bite he had for the rest of the day! The shaded SW bank suffered the most with just the odd Roach being caught. The water was still very cold with nothing coming from the deep middle sections.
