Date: 22nd August 2010.

Venue: Manor Farm Reservoir, Marden, Kent.

Conditions: Cloudy but warm & humid with a light breeze, poured with rain about 1.00p till the finish of the match, those without brollies got drowned! Water level about 2' down & clear.

Summary: Not the easiest of matches where all competitors had to work hard for their fish. It switched off early for some. The feeder wasn't that productive, unfortunately those who persevered with it were not rewarded with many fish, the small yearling fry were hitting the bait as it went down; the pole seemed to be the best weapon. No Carp, big Perch or Bream landed this time. Most bags consisted of Roach, Rudd, Skimmers with the odd Bream. The rain coming down in 'stair rods' didn't help; fishing under an umbrella can be awkward when casting. Jack pike were a pain chasing the roach on the way in, carp were quite active over by the reeds but none were surface feeding.
