Despite a few losses Barry found great amusement in trying to land small Roach before the Pike struck, at times it was actual leaping out of the water to get to the fish! Kevin decided to fish for them landed 4 up to 5lb. For most the last 2 hours were dead, Colin did manage to find & hold a shoal of nice Roach & by fishing light, single maggot was able to get third place.
