Conditions: A cool start that turned into a warm, sunny beautiful day, hardly any wind at all making it good for float & waggler fishing. Water level low slightly down but very clear!

Summary: Despite the excellent weather conditions day it proved hard, the fish just didn't want to know with most competitors struggling to catch. The Bream didn't show, just the odd skimmer. A number of good fish were lost on the pole; to get any bites competitors had to drop right down to a 20 & smaller. Barry lost 4 good fish using worm, could have been pike though, these were a nuisance especially where Jim was concerned, his catches having to 'run the gauntlet', despite this he still won easily, catching steadily all the morning. There seems to be an abundance of them now. Tony amused himself by dead baiting for them; they were taking anything, all small Jacks though. Those who stuck to the feeder were disappointed & unable to connect with anything worthwhile, It was a day for the pole.
Main baits that caught were pellet, maggots, & worm.
