Date: 9th November 2008.

Venue: River Beult, Cross-at-Hand, Kent.

Conditions: A cool, damp but cloudless start to the day with a light breeze. Later in the day the wind got up to be quite strong & gusty with some squally periods that fortunately didn't last long. Water level was high making & very coloured with plenty of reeds & bank rubbish being washed downstream however the consensus of opinion was it was still just about fishable & all agreed 'to give it a go'.

Summary: A low turn out with only 9 competitors, Saturdays wet conditions obviously put people off! Even with the river being a chocolate colour & running quite fast it was decided to give it a try. Barry & Don selected swims with fishable sections where there was some slack water in them. Colin found a shoal of Bleak close to the bank managing to take quite a few with just the top section of his pole using maggot & casters. Don managed to find a few Roach again tight to the bank & Kevin Nichols managed the only reasonable fish, a 2lb Bream; the rest of us struggled! Kevin Hunter lost a good Eel catching his line on a hawthorn bush whilst trying to land it. He modified the bush after with the aid of the landing net handle; unfortunately it is now a two piece one! Tony tried to open his broly in one of the squalls, not a clever thing to do resulting in it being wrecked also stepped back onto his landing net pole in the process! Another competitor once again broke a section of his pole, so an expensive day for some! Saying that, at least none of us blanked!
