Venue: **Toke Farm Reservoir, Kent.**

Conditions:

A beautiful warm sunny day with a slight NE breeze, a day for sun cream & hats!
Water level of the reservoir was high & clear, 2' visibility.

Summary:

With a good field of 19 competitors meant that every swim was used. This was the 2nd in the winter series, some confusion as all turned for the summer start times. The pole was the favoured & most successful method. The feeder just didn't give that good return, the large bream & Tench just didn't show. Bags contained Roach, Perch, Skimmers & Gudgeon. Don was successful on the pole in the SE corner swim relying on Skimmers & Roach, having to move up higher in the water to keep the Roach feeding later in the day. Despite breaking his pole before the start Jim did work hard to finish second, Barry managed third with another mixed bag on the North bank RH tree swim. The most successful bait was red or white maggot, the pellet just didn't seem to tempt any of the larger fish.
