Venue: Toke Farm Reservoir, Kent.

Conditions:

Bright sunny periods with an extremely cold NE wind. Reservoir level was down by 2', fairly clear with 2' visibility, water still very cold though.

Summary:

Another good field with 17 competitors to complete the first half of the winter series events. We were able to park nearer the reservoir as a special concession & arrangement with the landowner for matches only. With a bitterly cold NE wind it made it uncomfortable for most especially those fishing the Southern banks. Bream were the obvious target, unfortunately they were very few & far between, it was a struggle for all, Barry J had to wait for three hours before his first bite & fish, he managed to nail two Bream to take the honours; same with Don with a reasonable bream to gain second with Kevin H who drew 'pole position' in swim one starting with a Tench & a few Gudgeon then it died in the wind apart for a sorry looking Bream that gave him a shared second place. Barry A had another Bream & a couple a Roach to come in third. When you think of the number of skimmers in the venue & caught in summer time there were very few that appeared. Maggot seemed to be the most successful bait with those on the feeder picking up the odd Bream, again pole produced the small silver fish such as Roach, Perch & Gudgeon. We were blessed with a shower right at the death fortunately not heavy enough for the brollies!
