Date: **4th March 2007.**

Venue: **Staplehurst Reservoir, Kent.** (*Reserve venue used*)

Conditions: Due to the river Medway being high & like chocolate it was decided to use the reserve venue. Windy, cloudy, with the rain showers set in about mid morning & continued, another day for brollies. With all the recent rain water level was high brimming to full but fairly clear.
