2012 Summer League

Match No. 3

Date: 13th May 2012.

Venue: Stallance Reservoir, Sutton Valence, Kent.

Conditions:

A bright sunny start but with a cold SW breeze; clouded over during the day but remained warm with a increasing wind. With all the recent rain the Reservoir was full, slightly coloured with 18" visibility, water still cold though.

Summary:

The start of the summer league matches with another good field of 19 competitors. Once again exactly the same as last year with the waterfall end swims producing the first two places; Alex took the honours with a reasonable bag of Carp & Roach & Barry with similar in second place. Kevin started well hooking into a carp on the feeder within the first few minutes, this gave him third however despite being on the waterfall swim Alan struggled having to go light to get fish but it did earn him fourth place. Carp were most competitors target fish but alas few came out, they seemed to prefer the warmer shallower water with a few showing on the surface but not feeding.

A similar scenario as the previous two matches with the majority struggling to get fish even one or two blanked! Most had to be content with a few Roach, Perch & Crucian. The feeder into deep water did not work on this occasion with the pole or whip being the more productive method, again maggots, pellet & casters was the favoured bait. Fishing mid water & on the drop tight in against the reeds produced small Roach, a saviour for some. Once again a hard match for most but great weather!
