2011 Summer League

Match No. 2

Date: **15th May 2011.**

Venue: **Stallance Reservoir, Kent.**

Conditions:

A cloudy day with sunny periods but with a biting cold NE wind.
Water level of the reservoir was high & coloured, 18" visibility.

Summary:

With a fine turn-out of 17 competitors fishing the large reservoir meant that there was still a few swim spare. This was the start of the summer series, once again the 'match demons' made it hard work for most, one or two even struggled for bites. Again it was a case of swapping between the pole & feeder, those on the South & West bank had the cold blustery NE wind to contend with making the pole hard to handle. Maggots & pellet were the favoured bait. Alex in the sheltered NE corner was able to connect with the small carp to take first place, Tony in the SW corner bore the brunt of the cold wind but despite this was able to get second place on the waggler with a mixed bag of a Roach, Rudd & Perch (good to see the Perch coming out, these were only stocked from LPL last year.) Steve lost three good carp on the pole, disappointing after playing them for a long while but still managed third place. Once again the carp didn't show in any numbers, the change to a NE wind may have contributed!
