Date: 17th May 2009.

Venue: Stallance Reservoir, Sutton Valance, Kent.

Conditions: A cloudy cool start to the day with no breeze, however the weather deteriorated during the morning, by 10.30 the heavy rain & high winds had arrived with vengeance, this remained for the next two hours making fishing very difficult. The sun came out about mid day but the wind increased & it remained for the rest of the day. The water level was normal & slightly coloured.

Summary: An excellent field with a couple of new faces, hopes were high after recent reports on how well the venue been fishing with 50lb bags not uncommon! "Mower Man" had fished it the previous day with a catch of 47 carp up to 11lbs!... But you know fishing... especially on match days!
Apart from Barry & Colin M. the rest of us struggled, the carp were just not having it!
Majority started with the pole, Don managing to get smashed up twice within the first 15 minutes, unfortunately it would prove to be his only contact with any further fish!
With the wind the feeder rod seemed to be the only productive method, even with that it was hard to recognise the bites with most fish being caught at distance, a lot having to rely on the Roach & Rudd for any weights. Red maggot & pellet seemed the most productive baits.
To add to their pain Jim & Ralph both "totalled" their brollies in the gusting winds...
Hmmm... yet another expensive day for Jim! The conditions had a lot to answer for.
