Conditions: After the thunderstorms of the early hours & poor forecast everyone brought raingear, fortunately we all made it back to the cars just in time before the heavens opened!

It was a hot & humid day with high cloud cover, the variable breeze & sun didn't get up till midday followed by the heavy rain mid afternoon. Water level was slightly down with 18" visibility.

Summary: Once again a good turn out for this popular lake venue. A bit of a "luck of the draw" situation as some of the swims were a bit restricted. Those able to reach the main body of the lake were able to connect with the bream which was the main quarry. For some a quick start with some reasonable bream gave them hope for a brilliant day, this was short lived as the fish moved off causing them to struggle for the remainder of the match. Ralf had a good bag by fishing at distance with the feeder tempting them initially on pellet, then the remainder on maggots! Those who couldn't connect with feeder had to resort to the pole or waggler, catches consisted of Rudd, Roach & Perch, very few Tench caught this time however Barry did land a reasonable one ten minutes from the whistle, helped bump up his weight! Pete fishing the L/H reed swim lost quite a few carp on the light match tackle, landing one or two of those could have made all the difference! For the majority an enjoyable day, for some a frustrating one.
