Match No. 6

Date: 7th June 2009.

Venue: Linton Park Lake, Linton, Kent.

Conditions: A cloudy very damp start to the day. It started to rain about 7.00am. This turned into a torrential downpour where we all had to huddle up & do the draw under two umbrellas, despite their raingear most competitors were soaked through! The sun did appear about 10 am making it very warm on the point & other sunny swims however those under the trees were still being rained on! The wind was slight but changeable in direction however this time it did not pose that much of a problem for competitors. The water level was up & slightly coloured.

Summary: Again a good field. Due to the wet conditions Barry thought it only fair to delay the start for 20 minutes to allow everyone to sort their gear out & get set up. Within minutes Jim fishing the point swim was smashed up by a carp that took him into the pads, a good sign that the fish were feeding. Most competitors had mixed bags comprising of Roach, Rudd, Bleak, Perch, Skimmers & larger Bream that made up the better weights. Holding the fish in the swim was a problem for most, no monster bags of the larger Bream this time although Jim & Kevin seemed to be able to keep the fish interested for most of the morning. The fish started to come on again at the end of the match especially in Barry's & Colin's swims. A few stayed to fish on after the match to take advantage of the sunny day.

Most productive bait seemed to be maggots. All methods, Pole, Feeder & waggler produced.
