Conditions: Hot sunny day with a strong Southerly wind. Quite a bit of flow no doubt helped by the wind blowing downstream making it busy for the pole & waggler user! Water level was slightly down with 18" visibility.

Summary: Another good turn out for the first Summer visit to the Medway. Unfortunately we had to include a number of swims that were, how shall we say, eerr... challenging in the way they could be fished, putting quite a few at a disadvantage at the start. Underhand cast feeder or pole short trotting was only just possible for some. Those that did catch had mixed bags of Roach, Perch, Skimmers & Bream on a variety of baits, Maggots being the most productive; others struggled with the odd Bleak. Gudgeon & small Chub. Once again this match was won from the last swim in the second field, well done Alex. In conclusion we must consider spending a lot more time working on this section of river at future WP's. We have a number of fields out of which only 1½ get fished or rather are fishable, overhead trees & branches being the main problems + of course the elephant grass!
