Date: **21st August 2011.**

Venue: **Linton Park Lake, Kent.**

Conditions: A warm but cloudy day with sunny spells & light variable winds. Water level was slightly down with 18" visibility.

Summary: Again a good turn out for this venue, a bit of luck involved as to which swims the competitor drew, some are definitely a disadvantage but at least you can catch from all. Bream was the main quarry, most went on the feeder to start with fishing pellet & then the pole where conditions allowed. Again for the winner it ended in a two horse race with Ralf & Tony slogging it out fish for fish or rather Bream for Bream with Tony just piping Ralf at the end by a few ozs or so! It was good to see a few Tench coming out. Colin managed a fine bag of Roach on the pole. Maggots & pellet were the most productive baits, a combo with both on the hook worked well in some instances. Quite a number of Bream were caught from different swims, there now appears to be a very good head of these fish from 3 -5lbs average. Very few carp showing although they had been coming out earlier in the week.
